REMINDERS: Take *ATTENDANCE!* Use the app & let us know who to add/remove!

GAME: 🕵️👉 *PLAY Sherlock!* Everyone groups together. Each round, the player who is the detective will take 30 seconds to look at the group then leave the area. While they're gone, a change will take place (ex: two people change places, everyone unties their shoes). After the change, the detective comes back in and attempts to guess the change.

TOPIC OVERVIEW: When Andrew met Jesus, he didn't wait to learn everything about theology. He didn't take a class or get certified. He just ran to find his brother Peter and said, "We found the Messiah - you have to come see this guy!" That simple invitation changed Peter's life. And Peter's life changed thousands of others. And that chain of invitations has continued for 2,000 years - all the way to you. This week, Camp registration opens. Camp is a place where students have fun, build friendships, and encounter Jesus in powerful ways. For many students, Camp is where some might put their faith in Christ for the first time or take a major step in their relationship with him. You have friends who need to be there. Start by making a list of people you could invite. Then pray for them - that God would open doors and soften hearts. And then make the invite. It might feel awkward, but an invitation could be the thing that changes someone's eternity.

ICE-BREAKERS:

- What's heavier: a pound of feathers or a pound of nickels? Why?
- What's the best ice? (sonic, waterstill, etc)

MESSAGE DEBRIEF & BIBLE STUDY:

- What stood out to you from the video?
- **Read John 4:28-29.** What do you notice about this woman's encounter with Jesus?
- What stands out to you about her response?
- What are some things that stop you from telling others about Jesus?
- **Read 2 Corinthians 5:17-19.** What does it mean to be a 'minister' of reconciliation? What has reconciliation looked like in your life?
- Who is someone who shares their faith in a way you admire? What do they do?
- **Read 2 Timothy 1:7.** How does this passage encourage you to be bold in your faith?
- **Read Matthew 28:18-20.** Who is one person in your life you can take and share what you learned with this week?
- **Leaders,** pray over the names your group brings and for boldness for your students to take action.
