Preschool

ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning [child's name]! Today is a great day to listen and do what Jesus says."



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, thank You for Jesus. Thank you that He teaches us about You and Your kingdom."



Drive Time

While on the go, point out different street signs and how they tell us what to do. Say: "When we listen and do what Jesus says, God's kingdom grows!"



Bath Time

As you give your child a bath, play a game of Simon Says. Tell them to listen and do what you say. Say, "Touch your nose. Pat your head. Wiggle your fingers." Then say, "When you listen and do what Jesus says, God's kingdom grows!"
